BTEC Health & Social has been impacted by the COVID pandemic in the same way it has impacted all other subject areas. With this in mind the exam board have made certain concessions that students are aware of following classroom conversations. Concessions are outlined below alongside a timeframe for the completion of the course.

Component 3 Health & Well Being EXAM – This exam was not completed due to the pandemic. Students have however sat mock exams and these grades have been forwarded by Crestwood staff to the exam board. These have been accepted as accurate and grades have been awarded to students.

Component 1 Human Lifespan Development – This unit of work is currently being taught. This unit is the most likely to be called for external assessment. Students are aware that the work generated needs to reflect target grades as closely as possible. This sampling process will be in April/May.

Component 2 Health & Social Care services and Values— This unit of work is currently being taught. This unit is the most likely to be called for external assessment. The sampling process is where the exam board request the work of certain students. This checks the level of work against the standard of work and achievement nationally. Component 1 & 2 are critical in supporting the final grading decisions this year. Students should maximise their potential in these units prior to April/May sampling
